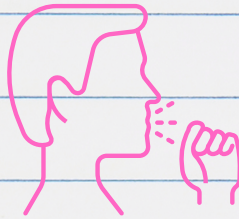


# RESPIRATORY

## Medications

### Antitussives

Codeine, Robatussine, Dextromethorphan



### Expectorants



Guaifenesin

Oral Corticosteroids Prednisone, Methylprednisolone

### Inhaled glucocorticoids

Betamethasone, Budesonide, Fluticasone  
Mometasone

### Sustained Beta Agonist

(Prototype Serovent/ Salmeterol)

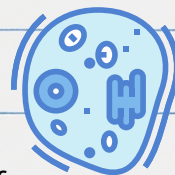
Long acting Beta agonist, used for maintenance therapy only, not a rescue inhaler



Inhaled glucocorticoids  
mixed with beta agonists  
Advir, Symbicort, Dulera

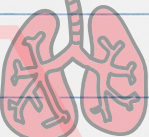
### Cromolyn Sodium

Mast cell degranulation inhibitor Effective for prophylaxis only and has no effect in an acute attack



### Inhaled Corticosteroids

Beclomethasone (QVAR)  
Budesonide (Pulmicort)  
Fluticasone (Flovent)  
Mometasone Furoate



### Methylxanthine or xanthines,

Treat airway obstruction, chem structure similar to caffeine  
Theophylline, more popularly prescribed Amalphylline



If a medication interacts with cytochrome p40, it will interact with

Coumadin, Tegretol  
Aspirin, Azithromycin  
Theophylline, Dilantin
